Year 11 Post-16 Options

We know that making decisions for future study after Year 11 is very important and that there are many pathways to consider. Throughout their time at Southmoor, we have provided students with careers education to enable them to ensure that they choose the most appropriate route to take in September 2024.

It is compulsory that all students are in some form of education, training or work-related learning until their 18th birthday. This does not mean staying in school, although many chose to continue studying full time within Sixth Form or with a further education provider. As a school, we are proud that from September 2022, 98% of students in the most recent Year 11 cohort were engaged in education or training.

Many students have already started to make decisions for their post-16 study. However, we are aware that some students have not yet decided on their plans and others need to consider back-up options. To support students and parents with these important decisions, we have collated below information about different further education providers, supporting resources and events that are taking place:

Unifrog Earlier this year, we sent a letter to all parents about Unifrog, our new online careers platform. Every student has their own login and profile on the Unifrog platform. Unifrog provides a one-stop shop to research post-16 and post-18

options. All further education courses are listed, including apprenticeships, and students can research possible pathways, shortlist these options and have information sent them via email.
